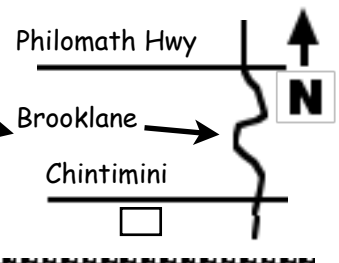
The Fire features Corvallis' own Rebecca Lomnicky, winner of the 2009 Glenfiddich International Scottish Fiddle Championship.



Share a song, lead a song, or listen as we go round the circle. (usually 2nd Sunday) Free and open to all.

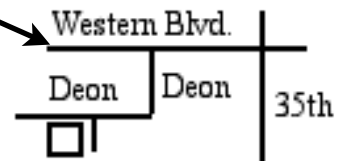
