An Evening with Verlon Thompson and Chris Arellano

What: As a solo performer and as the trusted sidekick of Texas Americana songwriting icon Guy Clark, Verlon has viewed the world from stages everywhere from Barcelona to Binger (his hometown in Oklahoma). Along the way Verlon Thompson compositions have been recorded by Jimmy Buffett and Alan Jackson, Dierks Bentley, Anne Murray, The Nitty Gritty Dirt Band, Kenny Rogers, Randy Travis, Del McCoury, Sam Bush, Trisha Yearwood and many more.

New CFS Fee Structure

At the meeting of the CFS Board prior to the membership meeting on May 19th, we agreed to reorganize the membership fee structure for CFS Members, starting the beginning of our new fiscal year on July 1, 2018.

In prior years, we have had a discount structure for families since we were sending only one CFS Newsletter to each address. After our transition to email delivery, and some time seeing how that has worked, we felt that it was appropriate to change the fees to recognize that for our purposes, a member and their email are bound more tightly than the member and their physical address. With that in mind, we have decided that CFS membership will be free for the children of members and that **each adult membership will be associated with a single email, with a fee of \$10 per year.** When your membership renewal notice comes to you, please choose the new "one size fits all" fee. If you and your family each wish to have their own membership, you should each sign up individually using your own email. As always, you may sign up or renew online or send in a check to CFS along with your contact information (or renew/sign up at an event).
