NEW ACTIVITY GROUP DISCUSSED:

Kurt Smith & Relan Coley proposed a new activity group, "Local Folk", to be a monthly gathering at the Corvallis Art Center to share music & songs in a supportive setting. Scheduled once a month on the 2nd Tuesday, beginning on April 9th, from 7-10 pm. Kurt Smith was designated group leader: will handle money, make deposits and report to the Board.

Board approved CFS support for this activity in conjunction with the Arts Center. Jason signed agreement for CFS

BEST CELLAR SOUND

Mark Weiss presented information about long-time CFS volunteer sound engineer, Larry Edger. Larry is considering retiring due to age & high physical demands of the job. Mark will be looking for another sound person and requested that the Board approve using proceeds from the June Benefit to establish a budget to fund sound at monthly Best Cellars.

Board approved Mark's retaining concert proceeds above the 7% to CFS for overhead. DISCUSSION followed regarding sound equipment and sound engineers. E.g. different types of equipment needed for different types of music in different venues.

Proposed: A committee to look into buying, owning, storing sound equipment to include: Mark Weiss, Dave Rabinowitz, Jason Schindler, Cliff Pereira, Erik Knoder. Jason & Mark will coordinate.

NEW DANCE:

Bill Hayden is interested in promoting more waltzing in the community. Discussion: ideas included a "waltz night", a waltz workshop before the contra, a variation on the 5th Saturday Contra dance. Jason said a monthly dance is a good way to start out. The Board whole-heartedly supported the idea. Bill was encouraged to seek ideas from other dance groups and to call on board members for support on various aspects of setting up a dance.
