ELECTRONIC PAYMENT: feasibility discussion continued from last meeting.

Square vs. Venmo: both are less popular now

PayPal: we already have an account Need to buy "dongle" to share

or separate accounts, one for each activity group/event

What kind of device needed to access?

- Easy for each user to use own cell phone
- Or could buy a CFS dedicated cell phone or tablet

TREASURER REPORT: Current Fiscal Year to date (July 1, 2019 to January 31, 2020).

Total Income = \$33,708 Total Expense = \$23, 198 Net Income = \$10,511 7%=(\$2,360)

Total Assets = \$78,931 Checking = \$76,930 Money Market Savings = \$2,001

NOTE: Mystery deposit on 1/8/2020 for \$66 needs to be identified. Jennifer Carlin?

EXPENDITURES: Money allotted for fans (\$150 approved in Sept 2019) not used yet, but will be.

MEMBERSHIP: Currently at 185 members (down 10 since Nov)

Only 17 have not "joined" Member Planet. Van to send list of lapsed and soon to be lapsed member contact info to secretary for follow-up

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NEWSLETTER: Some people have trouble finding the PDF link in the email sent to members. Request to Dick (by Van?) about formatting the link more clearly

CONCERTS: CFS-Whiteside collaboration

Rob checks with Chere before he lists a concert as being co-sponsored. Chere continues to send him some of the groups that contact her, and sometimes it works out. Chere continues to get questions about Whiteside show tixs, but it's ok.

John McCutcheon: Fri May 1st 2020. Tickets were just set up TicketTomato.

Note: people often like to get tickets early; TicketTomato is easy so no need to wait. Bigger shows at Whiteside can sell-out quickly (Carrie Newcomer, Wailin' Jennys)

BOARD REQUEST: CFS should receive notice of ticket pre-sales, as well as the date that the tix go on sale to general public. Dick/ Dave could add this information to the concert information in the Newsletter and Calendars

CONCERT EQUIPMENT: un-loading /on-loading

Hard work; we do not have not enough (or young enuff) volunteers

Ideas: Check with service clubs and fraternities for help;

Friends of the Library uses college kids - Anne will check with them.

Question: shouldn't payment to sound engineers should include their own load-in load & set-up of their own equipment

Check with Diane that her charge of \$400 covers her own un-loading & on-loading

SOUND EQUIPMENT: Kurt asked what CFS has and Van filled him in.

Someone needs to remind Erik Knoder to label all sound equipment with CFS identifying information. We also need a detailed inventory on file for insurance purposes

CONTRADANCE: OSU dance broke "even enough" to continue.

Goal is to have 2 dances in fall term, and 2 in Winter/Spring terms.

OSU Contra Club continues to have a "handful" of members; club hasn't met lately.

Regular Contra "come-back" payments: Jason will work out with Bill
