Choro is a Brazilian music style whose parents were Portuguese harmonies and African rhythms. In turn and in time, choro gave birth to other Brazilian forms like samba and bossa. Choro tunes are lively and lovely, traditionally played in a small ensemble. In that tradition, CnC is a quartet of 7-string guitar, 10-string bandolim, clarinet, and a hand drum called the pandeiro. We supplement the choro repertoire with songs from related Brazilian styles, sung in Portuguese. The Arts Center is a delightful small venue, the perfect setting for an intimate concert of this very fun music.

Old Blind Dogs are four musicians from very different musical backgrounds who came together to create a full time professional touring band, showcasing traditional songs and tunes of North East, Scotland.

Dàimh is a a Gaelic Supergroup - based around West Lochaber and the Isle of Skye. Hailed by John Renbourn as 'the best Celtic guitarist in the world' Tony McManus has been listed as one of the 50 transcendental guitarists of all time by Guitar Player Magazine. Ranked by peers and predecessors alike alongside the guitar world's all-time greats, his fiendishly dexterous, dazzlingly original playing draws on traditions from the entire Celtic diaspora – Scotland, Ireland, Brittany, Galicia, Asturias, Cape Breton, Quebec – along with still further-ranging flavours, such as jazz and east European music.

Editor's note: Alasdair Fraser & Tony McManus "return to KINTAIL" is one of my favorite CD's.

The first annual Corvallis Celtic Festival will be held July 21-23 in Central Park and downtown Corvallis.

Thursday July 20, 5-9pm- Kick off concert at Common Fields in Corvallis. This free concert will feature great music from 2 bands, raffles, and a roaring good time. Ten percent of all Common Fields sales for the day will go to support the festival.

Friday evening July 21 - Ticketed concert in Corvallis, location TBA.

Saturday July 22- All day event in Central Park and the Corvallis Arts Center. There will be an outdoor main stage with bands from near and far. Workshops and more intimate performances will be held inside the Corvallis Arts Center and others nearby venues. The day will include Ceili dancing, Celtic arts and crafts, Celtic history and genealogy, and children's activities. Participatory workshops will include instrument playing, singing and dancing. The day ends with an after hours Celtic Session in a downtown Corvallis venue.

Sunday July 23 - Events return to downtown Corvallis with more music and Celtic Sessions.
