Local Folk!, the Corvallis Folklore Society's open "mic" program, has returned, but now at the Troubadour

Thursday, Sept 4 Local Folk! is a free, monthly, open "mic" (without the mic!) program of local artists offering a wide variety of music, including original creations. There is no requirement to play and anyone is invited to just come and enjoy the music.

We have a **new location at THE TROUBADOR MUSIC CENTER**, 521 SW 2nd St, Corvallis.

Corvallis Folklore Society is so excited to partner with the Troubadour to bring back this long-standing community gathering. This is a monthly event, every first Thursday of the month.

Doors will open at 6:45pm and folks can sign up to perform at that time. Performances will be from 7pm-9pm. We will conduct shared performances for approximately two hours without a break, though people are free to move around.

This is an entirely acoustic event, without amplification. Each performer or performance group will have a maximum time allotment of 15 minutes to perform up to three songs, as in the past. We do not have a piano available at this time but if someone is able to help by providing a keyboard, that would be great. Contact Shari Ame at shariame@gmail.com. Kalos is made up of three innovative interpreters and composers of Celtic roots music: Eric McDonald (guitar/vocals), Ryan McKasson (fiddle) and Jeremiah McLane (accordion). They are masters of tradition who purposefully explore the dark corners floating on its edges, delivering an alluring musical complexity full of spontaneity and joyful exuberance. Their individual artistry is enhanced when together. In short, the sum creates a greater whole. Pulling from parallel strands of influence, they create a swirling level of intensity that traverses darkness, light, and everywhere in between. An air of mystery pervades a sound compelling enough to transcend boundaries and appeal to music lovers of all stripes. Devon Leger of Hearth Music says, "This trio really shows how masterful musicians listen and play off each other." The music they create is to share, and live performance is the forte. But their mutual attitude stretches beyond the music. They have been good friends ever since they met, and this is present in their live performances, which are full of organic banter and good humor to go along with the music. They create an environment of their own design, drawing in listeners without pretense. Despite living active musical lives thousands of miles apart these musicians have committed to working together to forge a new musical path.

Do you know about Oregon Cultural Trust Tax Credits? by Jennifer Parke, longtime CFS member

If you pay state income taxes and plan to donate money to support cultural nonprofit organizations like the **Corvallis Folklore Society**, you may wish to take advantage of the Oregon Cultural Trust Tax Credits program to reduce the amount of taxes you owe and double the impact of your donation.

Here's how it works:

- Step 1. You donate to one or more cultural nonprofits in Oregon, such as the Corvallis Folklore Society. Over 1,600 cultural nonprofits are listed on the Oregon Cultural Trust website; we are in the process of adding CFS to this list.
- Step 2. Go to the Oregon Cultural Trust online donation portal https://appengine.egov.com/apps/or/oct/donationpayment and by Dec. 31 of the same year make a matching gift to the Oregon Cultural Trust to earn tax credits: up to \$500 per individual, or \$1,000 per couple filing jointly.
- Step 3. When you file your state taxes, you apply the tax credits equal to 100% of your Oregon Cultural Trust donation to reduce the amount of taxes you owe. Tax credits provide much greater savings than a tax deduction.

Funds donated to the Oregon Cultural Trust are pooled and distributed as competitive grants to county and tribal cultural coalitions. CFS has already benefited from Oregon Cultural Trust funding! We were just awarded \$2,000 to support music and dance workshops at next year's Corvallis Celtic Festival. There are many charitable organizations worthy of your end-of-year donations. Not everyone is in a financial position to donate, but if you can, and you wish to support the arts and humanities, please consider donating to the Corvallis Folklore Society or other cultural nonprofit and then doubling the impact of your gift without additional cost to you using the Oregon Cultural Trust Tax Credit.
